Stoneware/porcelain

I seek the "quiet" curve in my throwing and focus on colour and texture, and often look to develop metallic lustres in my work. I like the flow of poured glazes and the subtlety of surface produced by varying the kiln atmosphere. I enjoy the "lucky accident" that is inherent in Raku. If I use surface decoration, I prefer stylised over naturalistic imagery.

Artist Bio

I worked as a production potter in the 1970s at a number of country potteries, for the old established West Country pottery, Brannams of Barnstaple and for myself. I changed direction to become an English teacher in Leicester and when I retired, reverted to my old metier. I now produce raku ware but also porcelain and stoneware working as an urban potter. I also run raku workshops in a number of locations. I sell my work at art fairs and in galleries, including WE ARE in the city centre.
